

## Notes to Contributors

Send submissions directly to the editors at [positions.on.modernism@gmail.com](mailto:positions.on.modernism@gmail.com). The file title should begin with the author's last name and include an abbreviated version of the article title (i.e. Surname\_Title.doc). Each manuscript must include, in a single DOC file, an author information page, an abstract, the full text of the article, endnotes, and a list of figures. Low resolution versions of all reproductions in JPG format should be included in separate files. Please do not send original photographs or high resolution images with the initial submission, nor should you imbed images in the manuscript file. Also, do not send the manuscript as a PDF file or any file other than DOC or DOCX.

### **Author Information**

The first page of the manuscript should list the following information: author's name, title, mailing address, e-mail address, phone number and institutional affiliation. Some authors may also choose to include a 75- to 100-word bio. This page is the only place in the manuscript where the author's name or any other identifying information should appear.

### **Abstract**

The second page of the manuscript should consist solely of an abstract summarizing the argument and defining the methodological approach of the article in no more than 150 words.

### **Article**

The manuscript must be written in English, double-spaced, saved as a DOC or DOCX file, and contain not more than 6,000 words of text (excluding endnotes). Exceptions to these requirements may occasionally be made by prior arrangement with the editors. Pages are to be numbered consecutively throughout and page numbers should be noted in the lower right hand corner of each page.

Quotations from foreign languages must be translated into English in the text, with the original given in the endnote only if necessary. While individual foreign words will be italicized in the final printed text, they should be shown in the manuscript with underlining. All other editorial issues may be resolved by consulting the Chicago Manual of Style or contacting the editors.

### **Endnotes**

Endnotes style should follow the Chicago Manual of Style (15th edition).

### **List of Figures**

Each manuscript must include a list of illustrations with figure captions. The order of information is: designer, name of the building or object, location, date, description, source of image. If a building has been destroyed, include that information. The caption may also be used to direct the reader to a salient part of the image. Illustrations should be numbered consecutively in order of mention in the text.

### **Images**

Low resolution images (no more than ten) should be sent by e-mail with the initial submission of the manuscript. The image file titles should be numbered consecutively and include the author's surname, for example: 01-Surname.jpg, 02-Surname.jpg, 03-Surname.jpg, etc. The editors will assume these will be replaced with high quality, high resolution scans in the published version. Under no circumstances should authors submit low resolution scans of images where they do not have access to high resolution versions for which they can obtain rights to publication. Authors are responsible for obtaining onetime, English language, world rights to reproduce illustrations when necessary and paying all copyright fees and other costs prior to publication. Copies of the written permission letters for each illustration will be required if a manuscript is accepted for publication.

When an article is accepted for publication, the editors will provide detailed instructions about the requirements for final submissions.
